General safety instructions for fire protection, escape and rescue routes



- Pay attention to the escape and rescue routes that you can use in an emergency. It is essential to follow the instructions in the escape and rescue plan and, if applicable, the alarm plan.
- Go to assembly point (assembly point 1: in front of main entrance to building A, assembly point 2: shipping area, assembly point 3: in front of building E).

First Aid



• First aid kits see escape and rescue route plan



• Locations: Automated external defibrillator AED (shift supervisor's office Injection moulding department, reception building section A, canteen building section E)

Personal protective equipment



- high-visibility vest
- The issued PPE has to be returned after the end of the work.
- During the production tour we recommend wearing safety shoes min.
 S1P or safety caps.

Moving around the factory premises



- Attention on traffic routes, use marked green paths. Watch out for the blue dots on the ground. They indicate that a forklift is approaching.
- Use the attached mirrors to be able to see unclear places.
- Always keep 3m distance to operating forklifts, show consideration
- Do not step into the working area of moving industrial trucks.

Miscellaneous





- Observe safety signs (mandatory signs, prohibition signs, warning signs, hazardous substance symbols).
- Do not enter work areas without authorization.



Corona
